

## 2018 Grants Awarded

**¡Adelante Latina!**: Our funds will support this free of charge, three-year, after school, college preparatory program for underprivileged Latina girls in the Baltimore City school system.

***Grant Amount: \$2,800***

**Asylee Women Enterprise**: Our funds will help AWE meet their increased need for case management, advocacy, social support and parenting skills for the community of asylum seekers, asylees and refugees that they support.

***Grant Amount: \$20,000***

**Baltimore Hunger Project**: Funding will provide weekend food packets to 40 food insecure students at Lillie May Carroll Jackson Charter School for the full school year and provide all students with the opportunity to participate in packing sessions at Baltimore Hunger Project.

***Grant Amount: \$9,700***

**Higher Achievement Baltimore**: Higher Achievement (HA) provides high quality after-school and summer programming to middle school youth in Baltimore City. Our funds will allow HA to continue to pilot a three-year project that focuses exclusively on girls. Approximately 60 girls will participate in gender-based S.T.E.M. and life skills programming with the goal of addressing both the gender gap in the S.T.E.M. fields and the achievement gap associated with poverty.

***Grant Amount: \$20,000. This is the third year of a three-year grant.***

**Jewish Community Services**: JCS will develop and deliver addiction prevention programs specifically tailored to address the unique factors that place teenage girls and adult women at risk of addiction and overdose and create obstacles to recovery and treatment.

***Grant Amount: \$5,000***

**Marian House**: Our funds will support the education program that provides critical academic and tutoring support to residents of Marian House, a transitional shelter and support services program for homeless women.

***Grant Amount: \$15,000***

**NATAL**: Funding will provide resiliency training in Israel to early childhood educators of all backgrounds to support children affected by trauma due to war and to act as advocates for trauma awareness and resiliency in their communities.

***Grant Amount: \$20,000***

**Orr Shalom**: Orr Shalom provides homes and support to children in Israel who have been removed from their families due to abuse or neglect. Our funds will support their most vulnerable girls, ages 16 to 28, as they transition from Orr Shalom's care to self-sufficiency.

***Grant Amount: \$20,000***

**PeacePlayers International**: PeacePlayers uses the game of basketball to bridge divides, change perceptions and develop leaders. Our funds will support two young women's All-Star teams on which Arab and Jewish girls compete together, empowering and amplifying their voices for equality and co-existence.

***Grant Amount: \$20,000***

**Tahirih Justice Center**: Our funds will support the cost of delivering free, holistic, and lifesaving legal and social services to immigrant women and girls fleeing gender-based persecution and violence.

***Grant Amount: \$15,000***
